Key points from reports:

- Airedale Reports from Sp-ICE do not feed into WinPath therefore results such as antibody reports have to be copied and pasted into WinPath.
 AC advised that there is a pilot underway which will assist with this issue.
- Bradford Success with an off site day unit. Learning point would be to include a second blood fridge.
- Calderdale & Huddersfield Work ongoing on information / contact for patients post discharge. MK/CL are working on a survey for reporting of transfusion reactions in patients that have left the Hospital (see item 10.2) Introduced a pre pickup check list on BloodTrack for TACO Reducing in midwife sampling rejection rates following a 'back to basics' campaign. Midwifery manager has introduced a seven minute brief to go through transfusion sampling with good results.
- CDDFT TP currently investigating how best to introduce weight based red cell dosing.
- Harrogate Trend in inappropriate use of O neg in ED. Recognised that they have a junior team and empowerment training is to be given.
- Hull Training has been going very well, they hold monthly workshops for nonmedical staff and competency sessions for doctors as well as induction days.
 Action Confirm what has been implemented
- Leeds Incompatible transfusions due to positive patient ID (bank staff). Drive within the Trust with quality safety matters and escalated to the risk team.
- Mid Yorks Addressing training doctors for sample taking and use of TX. Limited time available at doctors inductions.
 - Other Trusts reported they have introduced bespoke elearning packages. BloodTrack TX has a hard stop built in, staff cannot use the system unless training completed.
 - Passports between Trusts would be beneficial but minor changes in systems within Trusts may be an issue.
- South Tees Piloting QTA tracers to see if they can reduce wastage
 Working on bridging the gap between order comms and end authorisation system.
 Newcastle has implemented successfully.
- York & Scarborough Overnight transfusion audit, looking at how to target education for junior medical staff and empower nursing staff to state when transfusions should not be happening out of hours.

CI - Request from patient who has shared care with Leeds. Mum is pregnant and son has Fanconi anaemia, she is asking if she can store cord blood in case her son requires a stem cell transplant. MK advised that she can, her clinical team will need to contact NHSBT cord blood for instructions. MK - Asked if NHSE are to communicate with Trusts re: IBI. RP advised that it is likely the NBTC will respond with a summary for HTCs. KEG - Advised that the Albumin shortage is causing problems for patients and requested that Trusts collect data on any patients coming to harm AM advised that Newcastle has also been affected by the albumin shortage. It has been very stressful and she will put her name to anything we put in place. Action: Consider way forward. KEG - Noted email from NHSBT Hospital Customer Service - Pre Amber Stock Alert KEG - Asked if the cyber-attack in London effected the blood ordering system. BT advised that it has affected the service as everything to be done manually. No note of any Trusts outside London being affected. BT noted that Trusts with integrated IT systems need to have contingency plans.
