## Promoting Informed Consent

### 2023 NCA AUDIT OF NICE QUALITY STANDARDS 138

The 2023 audit of QS138 has been published and the full report and key findings can be accessed by clicking the image



Disappointingly, only 475/1356 (35%) of transfused patients had evidence of receiving both written and verbal information about the risks, benefits and alternatives to transfusion (compared to 26% in the 2021 audit)

### QS 138 QUALITY INSIGHTS

A key recommendation from the NCA QS138 audit is that hospitals should undertake regular repeat audits of the NICE Quality Standard using the National Comparative Audit and the QS138 Quality Insights tool as a quality improvement initiative

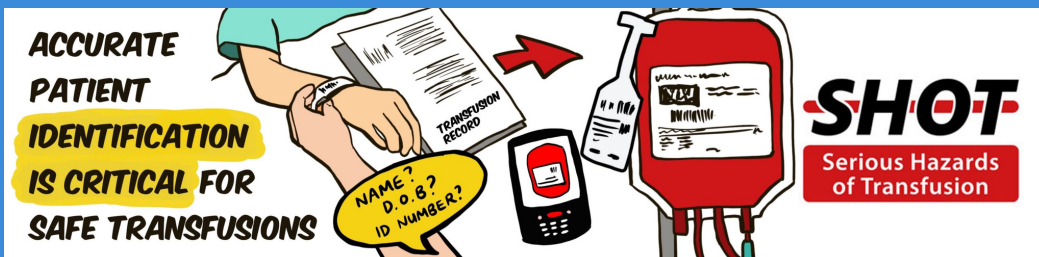
### PATIENT INFORMATION LEAFLET - RECEIVING A BLOOD TRANSFUSION
