Welcome to the 2025 activity summary report for the East of England Regional Transfusion Committee

It has been a pleasure to be the Chair of the EoE RTC this year. The RTC is a hive of knowledge and passion for patient care where all members of the team can share their experience, hopefully gaining insights on how to improve care. Our meetings are a mix of face to face and virtual to account for our geographically diverse Region. Meetings for individual areas continue to be well represented with 7 other TP and TADG meetings a year separate to the RTC.

Meetings – 3 RTC meetings were held during 2025. There was good representation at the meetings with 42 colleagues attending in January, 26 colleagues attending in May and 18 colleagues attending in October. A variety of topics were covered over the year including talks and presentations on:-

TADG Meetings - 3 TADG meetings were held during 2025. Topics have included temperature mapping, implementing a LIMS system, stock sharing and audits.

This was a really beneficial face-to-face meeting which included a fascinating presentation and the use of virtual reality (VR). Attendees had the opportunity to try the VR headsets.
